TiE Women India

Perkant Tech was co-founded by Saniya Jeswani along with Lokant Jain, in 2020. Their core product is called “Abhay Parimiti” – an AI-powered medical device capable of conducting a health scan in under 60seconds. It works even in settings that don’t have immediate medical professionals. The device monitors over 700 signals/biomarkers, is designed for both rural and urban use, and aims to democratize preventive healthcare. Perkant Tech raised INR 6.6 crore in their seed round led by YourNest Venture Capital, with additional backing from Atal New India Challenge, Villgro Foundation, and Sanchi Connect. They also secured an Indian patent for their device; a U.S. patent is “pending.”. Since winning the TiE Women Program in 2004, Perkant Tech has gained:

- Access to mentorship and investor networks.
- Strengthened its market presence by expanding its client base.
- Enhanced its product offerings and aligned more closely with sustainability and innovation-driven goals.

Green Climate Concave 2025




